

- Step 1 -Determine Mounting Height

Safety: Take consideration for the users height.



- A) Mounting height:
 Minimum of 54" above
 floor, usually 5-1/2' 6'.
 Avoid mounting at
 adults eye level(s) if
 possible. (see fig. 1)
- B) Mark a dot 3/4" in from the frames edge at the mounting height. (see centerlines fig. 2) Check height for ease of use and eye safety.
- C) Using the 1" spade bit, drill a shallow recess approximately 1/8" deep (.125" -.138") at mark.


- Step 2 -Fitting Base Plate

- Step 3 -Mount Base Plate & Assembly

Use shaft and base plate as a guide.

- A) Place shaft centered vertically in recess to mark doorframe above and below the shaft.
- B) Remove a portion of frame with a utility knife to accommodate shaft, approx. 3/32" deep. (see grey area on fig. 2)
- Place base plate in recess, nut side down, fit shaft over pins and hold horizontally. (see note)
- D) Mark center of the diagonal holes where screws will go, pre-drill as necessary.

Note: you may have to enlarge center hole to accommodate nut.

Mounted assembly should be nearly flush with the door frame, shim if necessary.

- A) Mount base plate. Using the 2" screw in the hole furthest from the edge of door frame and the 3/4" screw closest to the edge. Make sure the shaft (pins) will be horizontal to the ground when mounted.
- B) Assemble the shaft to the base plate using the cover plate and machine screw.

Note: Later when shaft is removed, the base mount can remain in place and won't affect the door's function.


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- Step 4 -Mount Door Clip



- A) Place metal clip with the barb hooked over the door's edge and bend the overhanging tab to form a "U" so the clip now fits the thickness of the door use pliers if necessary.
- B) Mount the clip at the exact height of the shaft, aligning the barb with the hook for a proper catch using the two small clip screws.

FOR CONTINUED PROTECTION*

Routinely check assembly for:

- 1. Loose screws & parts
- 2. Adequate curve in shaft
- 3. Hook / Barb alignment
- 4. Overall function

Latch can be over-ridden using a stick or stool, etc. - keep items away from doors with latches.

*Add self-closing hinges for additional safety.

Different mounting methods available contact us with your situation.

- Arcadia (sliding) door mount,
- Metal door iamb countersunk rivets.
- Double doors make one fixed, etc.
